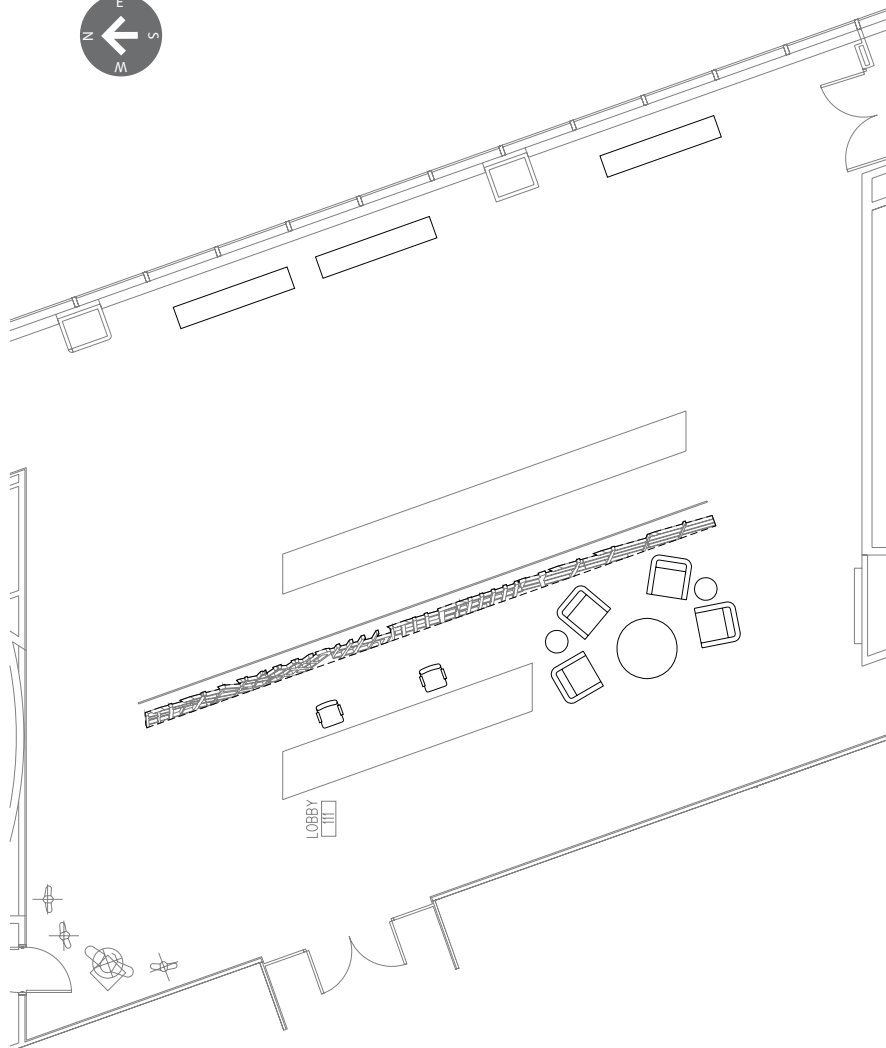

LOBBY

The New York Academy of Sciences' sweeping reception area is perched cloud-high-in-the-sky. A striking sculptural metal art wall, depicting downtown's street grid and the Academy's history in New York since its inception in 1817, bisects the blond quarter cut aguire wood-clad space. The undulating openwork sculpture separates the space into a traditional reception area with seating and a pre-function space featuring a permanent credenza for check-in and catering, a manned coatroom, monitors listing event information and three large flat panel screens utilized for branding opportunities. Beyond the soaring floor-to-ceiling windows is a giant's eye-view of the city; on a crystal clear day guests see from river to river with notable landmarks like the Brooklyn Bridge, Empire State Building, and the George Washington Bridge laid out 40 floors below the 2,853 sq. foot space.
