The *Tata Transformation Prize* supports breakthrough, innovative technologies that address India's greatest challenges. By recognizing and supporting the implementation at scale of high-impact research, the Prize drives innovation in scientific disciplines of importance to India's societal needs and economic competitiveness.

The Prize leverages the exceptional potential of scientists in India to address critical national challenges in three categories—**Food Security, Sustainability, and Healthcare**—and generate improved life quality outcomes across India and beyond.

The Tata Transformation Prize recognizes one Winner in each of the three categories, with each Winner receiving INR 2 crores (approximately US\$230,000), a personalized medal inscribed with their name and Prize year, and a lifetime membership to The New York Academy of Sciences.

Eligibility

The applicant must:

- Hold a doctoral degree (PhD, DPhil, MD, DDS, DVM, etc.)
- At the time of application, hold a position as a Postdoctoral Researcher, Faculty, or Researcher/Scientist, with at least 50% full-time effort devoted to research, at an eligible institution within India
- Receive pre-approval from their institution in the form of an Eligibility Verification Form.

Applicants may only submit one application per annual Prize cycle.

Application Materials

All applicants must submit:

- Applicant's Curriculum Vitae
- Applicant's Innovation Proposal (maximum five pages)
- Names and email addresses for two letter writers
