

What is the Science Alliance?

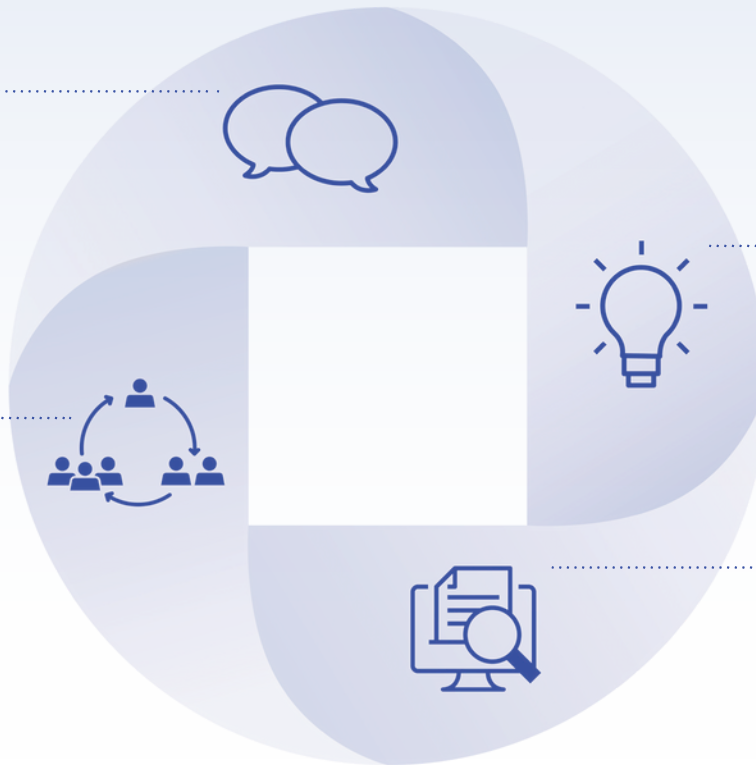
